- Go to <u>www.batavialibrary.org</u> and click on the Zinio link
- This is a trusted connection (If needed, click on "I Understand the Risks" and "Add Exception")
- Select the purple Create Account button
- Enter your library card number and click the green Validate button
- Enter your email address, choose a password, and your first and last name.
 Then click Create Account
- Check your email for a confirmation and click on the Activate Account link in that email. An Internet browser window will open and take you back to the Nioga Library System Zinio page
- Log into Nioga Library System Zinio with your email address and password
- Browse the magazines and select a title
- This will take you to the Zinio.com magazine page

At this point you will need to create a Zinio.com account.

- Enter your first and last name along with the same email address you used above.
 Choose a password and enter it.
- Tip: Use the same e-mail address and password that you used to sign up for the account with the library. This will make things easier when you try to sign into your account to checkout and access your magazine issues.
- If you choose to do so, you can uncheck the box for "Send me email updates."



- Go to <u>www.batavialibrary.org</u> and click on the link the Zinio icon
- At the login page, enter your email address and password. Select Log In
- You will arrive at the Nioga Library System collection page.
- Select the title you want to read
- You will arrive at the Zinio.com login page.
 Enter your email address and password to sign in
- Your magazine collection should be available for you to read



Reading on your mobile device

- For Apple or Android devices, or if using a Kindle Fire or Blackberry Playbook, download the Zinio app from your App Store (for free)
- Open the App and Access the settings in the App
- Sign in with your email address and password
- Your Library Zinio Magazines that you preselected will be available for download once you have logged in.
