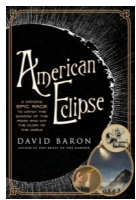

This will be a free outdoors event. Space will be available on a first come basis, bring a chair or blanket.

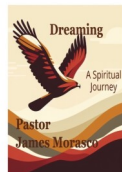
We will host lawn games, citizen science stations for taking data readings during the eclipse, food trucks, and more.

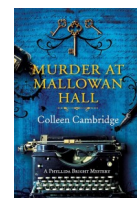

You only need basic computer skills & an active email account.

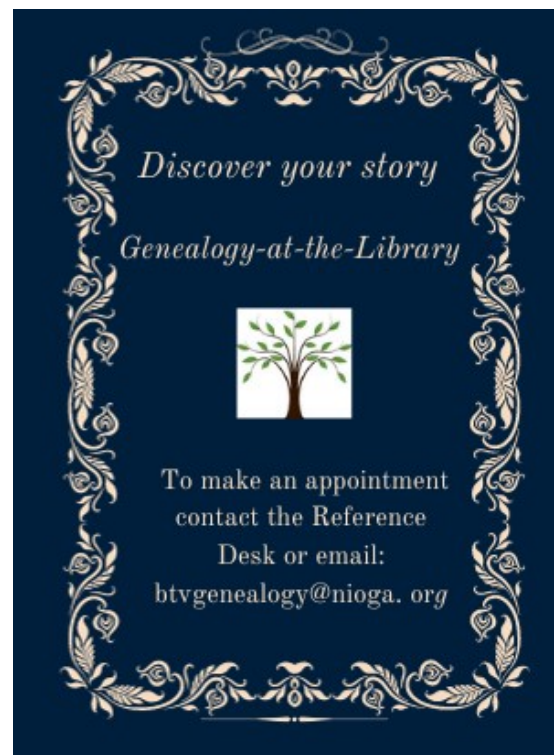
