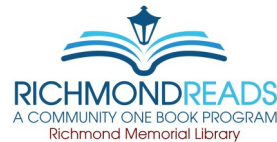

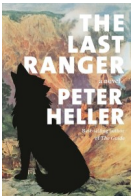

Other small travel sized toiletry items- bar soap, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, etc.

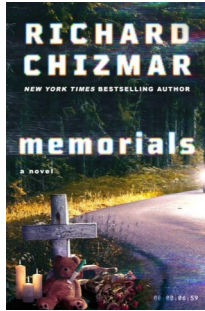
